### Announcements

#### For safety purposes,

- Please do not send your child to daycare wearing jewelry( i.e. necklaces, dangle earrings)
- All children should wear shoes appropriate for outside play each day.
- Do not bring a toy from home.
- Please do not give your child gum or hard candy before arriving. These are not permitted in daycare and present a choking hazard.
- Please make sure that your pick up information is complete. It is the daycare policy that we can only release your child to someone with your written authorization accompanied with a photo ID.
- If you want to celebrate your child's birthday, please talk to the teachers in advance.
- Please try to have your child potty-trained by age three (we will work together!)
- Check your child's cubby and always have an extra set of clothes available when needed.
